About this SPDS

This Supplementary Product Disclosure Statement (SPDS) supplements and amends the following Combined Product Disclosure Statement and Policy Wording (PDS):

- mi-bike Off Road Rider Insurance PDS – prepared on the 1 October 2021

This SPDS must be read together with the above mentioned PDS. The preparation date of this SPDS is 23 November 2021.

This SPDS shall apply to all new and existing policies, effective 1 January 2022 unless otherwise specified. **You** should keep these documents in a safe place. Please contact **Yamaha Motor Insurance Australia** if **You** require a copy of any previous PDS issued by **Us** to **You**.

The purpose of this SPDS is to notify **You** of the following changes:

1. About the Insurer

From 1 January 2022, the Insurer is a signatory to the General Insurance Code of Practice (the Code). The Code was developed by the Insurance Council of Australia to further raise standards of practice and service across the insurance industry. The Code Governance Committee (CGC) is an independent body that monitors and enforces insurers' compliance with the Code.
